## **State Representative Paul Adams Honored at Reagan Day Reception**

ANDOVER - Representative Paul Adams was honored at a celebration this week held in honor of former President Ronald Reagan, who would have turned 100 on February 6. John Moffitt, Andover Republican Town Committee Chairman, welcomed over one hundred people to the event. Moffitt was the campaign manager for Reagan during his 1980 presidential bid, which was the last time a Republican managed to carry Massachusetts in a presidential race. Moffitt went on to serve as Reagan's campaign manager for Massachusetts in the 1984 presidential election. Event Chairman Gary Coon, a former Republican State Representative from Andover during the 1990s, State Republican Party Chairwoman Jennifer Nassour and Andover Selectman Brian Major were among those who also attended.

Representative Adams said, "President Reagan showed us that lower taxes and less spending are powerful tools which help grow the economy and create private-sector jobs.
