Rep. Paul Adams Receives Committee Assignments

ANDOVER—State Representative Paul Adams, R-Andover, received his committee assignments from Minority Leader Brad Jones, including: (i) Co-Ranking Member, Joint Committee on Revenue, formerly known as Taxation; (ii) Ranking Member, Joint Committee on Telecommunications, Utilities and Energy; and (iii) Ranking Member, Joint Committee on Public Health.

Representative Adams commented, “I’m very excited for these committee assignments because they will allow me to focus on the key issues impacting my constituents: Lower taxes on businesses and individuals; reforming healthcare through free-market policies that will lower costs; and on challenging elements of our current energy policy, which heavily subsidizes electricity production at 4 to 5 times the existing cost per megawatt.”

Representative Adams emphasized: “I will provide the people with an unrelenting voice of reason while seeking compromise. In particular, I will fight to strengthen free-market policies necessary for economic growth, including: lower taxes, local aid as a top budget priority, controlled spending, a reformed pension system, and fighting to alleviate burdensome mandates and wasteful subsidies. These are strategic imperatives required to keep our Commonwealth an attractive place to live and labor.”

Adams continued: “I’m appreciative to Minority Leader Jones for the leadership roles he’s entrusted to me, and I’m most grateful to the people of Andover, Lawrence and Tewksbury for the great trust they have placed in me.”
